## Town of Irondequoit Fire Districts: Existing Conditions and Options for the Future Presentation on the Report

On May 26<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm at the St. Paul Boulevard Fire Station at 433 Cooper Road, CGR will be presenting their report **Town of Irondequoit Fire Districts: An Analysis of Existing Conditions and Options for the Future**. The report details the existing operations of the five fire districts in Irondequoit – Laurelton, Point Pleasant, Ridge Culver, St. Paul Blvd. and Sea Breeze. The report also identifies several options for the fire districts to consider as they face challenges in the future. These options include maintaining the status quo, expanding shared services and the potential merger of two or more of the districts. The public is encouraged to attend or participate online to hear about the fire service operations in the town and about potential changes for the future.
